

## RULES GOVERNING STABLING ON THE FAIRGROUNDS

(By order of the Fair Board of Directors, these rules are to be STRICTLY enforced. In the event of failure to observe a first warning, renters will be evicted from the fairgrounds and disqualified from further stabling privileges.)

1. No horse may be stabled until the owner or agent has first signed the required State Form F-31, "Rental Agreement" and a \$200.00 deposit. This deposit shall be a guarantee of compliance with the rules and its refundable when the stall is vacated and cleaned.
2. Monthly stall rent is to be paid IN ADVANCE, on or before the first day of each month and becomes delinquent after ten (10) days. A finance charge of 1½% per month will be charged on all accounts past due. Rent will accrue until renter has notified the fair office in writing or by person that the stall has been vacated.
3. Specific stall and/or tack room will be assigned to each renter and no others are to be used without prior permission from the fair office. It is required that renter provides access to stalls or duplicate stall keys (not tack room keys) in the fairgrounds office for use in case of emergency and/or inspection. Keys kept in the fairgrounds office will not be loaned to anyone, including the owner, under any circumstances.
4. NO STALLIONS MAY BE STALLED ON THE FAIRGROUNDS.
5. Stalls must be cleaned daily and refuse removed to a designated area. Horses must be fed and watered daily. Neglect or misuse of any animal is cause for immediate cancellation of the stabling agreement and will be reported to the local animal control officials.
6. Horses must be physically attended at all times, except when inside closed stalls. They must be exercised only in the infield north of the stables, in the walking ring south of the stables, in the horse show or rodeo arenas, or in such other areas as may be temporarily designated by the Association. The Association reserves the right to restrict use of these arenas and areas on such occasions as it deems necessary. Horses are not allowed on parking lots except for direct passage between the stable area and the horse exit gate at the extreme south end of the main parking lot. All other portions of the fairgrounds are off limits for horses at all times.
7. The Association may require that stalls be vacated and horses relocated or removed for the fairgrounds for the conduct of the annual fair or at any other times for reasonable cause. Renter must leave his stall(s) clean and in good condition when vacating.
8. Horse trailers may be stored on the fairgrounds with prior permission from the Association, but must be kept in designated areas.
9. Each renter will be held responsible for damage done to the Association's property which occurs as a result of his occupancy. The Association is not responsible for injury to animals or loss of renter's property left on the fairgrounds.
10. Violation of any of the above rules is cause for termination of stabling agreements without advance notice.
